

Public Hearing  
Proposed Waste Water Utility Rates and Charges  
Camden Town Council  
August 14, 2017  
Camden-Jackson Public Library

The properly called and advertised public hearing on enacting a sewer rate change was opened by Council President Andrew Robison at 7:00pm. In attendance for the hearing were Members Mark Schock and Brent Deel, Clerk-Treasurer Pat Casserly and one guest.

Mr. Robison explained the rate change as being adjusted to reflect the proposed storm water fee and the rates being structured to have a minimal effect on the customers. H. J. Umbaugh prepared the rate structure and following discussion the Council accepted the new rates as proposed. The Clerk-Treasurer asked for direction on setting the flat rate for the one customer who is serviced by the sewer only; this customer does not have water service as the property has a well. The decision was made to adjust the flat rate to reflect the same net change as those billed by gallons of water used.

The public hearing on the proposed waste water utility rates and charges adjourned at 7:10 by a motion from Mr. Robison, seconded by Mr. Schock.
