

CAMDEN TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
TOWN OF CAMDEN INDIANA
OCTOBER 9, 2024

The Camden Town Council met in a legally advertised meeting on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 at 7:00 PM in the Library Reading Room.

Those present were: President, Mark Schock, Member, Andy Robison, (via phone), Marshal Jill Hammond, Utility Superintendant Jerry Snavelly and 2 Guest.

President Schock open a Public Hearing regarding the Adoption of the 2025 Budget by asking if there were any questions regarding the advertised budget totals. There being none, he asked the council if they were in favor of the proposed totals and made a motion to Adopt. Schock then made a motion to close the Public Hearing, seconded by Robison.

Schock then opened the Public Hearing regarding the Water Grant Proposal. Emily Albaugh from KIRPC led the hearing by stating the Town would be applying for the same \$700,000 grant that was just denied due to low scoring. She stated that it would help if residents would write letters stating any water complaints they have. There being no further questions, the hearing was closed.

Mr. Schock lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance after opening the regular meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Robison and a second from Mr. Schock to approve the minutes of the September 2024 meeting as well as all Dockets and reports submitted.

Utility Superintendant, Jerry Snavelly stated that he had nothing to report this month.

Marshal Jill Hammond gave her report as attached.

Clerk Treasurer, Jeff Sieber was not present at the meeting, however left word that if the council was wanting a Christmas Tree for the town, it would need to be getting ordered. It was decided, after discussion to get 2 smaller trees for each side of the Community

Building doors instead of 1 large tree for the parking lot. This will eliminate the loss of parking spaces and allow visibility when backing out on to Main Street.
A council member has been requested to attend the zoning meeting regarding the new Dollar General. Mr. Schock said he would attend the meeting.

Trick or Treat was set for Thursday, October 31, from 6-8 PM.

Next meeting will be held November 13, 2024.

Mr. Schock made a motion, seconded by Mr. Robison to adjourn at 7:16 PM.
