

CAMDEN TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

JANUARY 8, 2025

The Camden Town Council met in a legally advertised meeting on Wednesday, January 8, 2025 at 7:00 PM in the Library Reading Room.

Those present were: President, Mark Schock, Member, Andy Robison (via phone), Clerk Treasurer, Jeff Sieber, Marshal Jill Hammond, Utility Superintendant Jerry Snavely and 1 Guest.

Mr. Schock lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance after opening the regular meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Robison and a second from Mr. Schock to approve the minutes of the 2024 End of Year meeting as well as all Dockets and reports submitted.

Election of officers was held, and by a motion from Mr. Robison and second by Mr. Schock, the 2025 officers will stay the same as previous year.

A motion was made to reappoint the names listed for each of the committees for 2025. Motion passed. List attached.

Discussion was held on what the council is wanting to do regarding the Live Streaming that the town will need to start doing on July 1. No decision was made as to how this will be handled yet.

The Annual Chamber of Commerce dues were agreed upon to be paid for this year, keeping us at the Platinum level with the Chamber.

Invoice was also received from the EDC and it was decided that no action would be taken on that payment until the council sees what direction the EDC would be going since they were losing their Director.

The latest update from the Dollar General project was that they had applied for a Stormwater permit thru IDEM. As far as everyone was aware, all of the county permits have been received.

Next meeting will be held February 12, 2025.
